DAILY ITINERARY

다August 2, Saturday, Day 1: ARRIVAL IN MEXICO CITY

Depart from your home airport for a flight to Mexico City. We arrive in Mexico City, where our group transfer will be arranged. You will be informed of the time. You may also take a taxi to the hotel in Mexico City if you arrive after the transfer departs. The taxi service at the airport is well-monitored and organized. Check-in at the hotel is after 4 PM. Mass will be celebrated at the hotel late afternoon, or early evening. We gather for a welcome drink before dinner. Overnight in Mexico City. (Welcome get-together plus dinner at the hotel) (D) (The program may change based on flight arrival time)

Each day of our pilgrimage will start with breakfast, followed by a morning conference with Dr. Howard and Holy Hour at our hotel. In the afternoon, we will visit sites in Mexico City. Fr. Blount will celebrate the daily Private Masses. Group dinners will be arranged.

다August 3, Sunday, Day 2: MEXICO CITY – OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

Our day starts with breakfast at the hotel, followed by a morning conference and Holy Hour. In the afternoon, we visit Our Lady of Guadalupe Shrine, where we celebrate Mass and visit the Basilica. We have time to visit the Tilma and explore the shrine's grounds, including the Museum, Tepeyac Hill, Capilla del Cerrito, Tepeyac Garden, Chapel of the Indians, and more. There will also be time for personal devotions. Lunch is not included in the cost but will be planned. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City. (B.D)

다August 4, Monday, Day 3: CHURCH OF SAN JOSÉ DEL ALTILLO – BLESSED CON-CHITA CABRERA – CHURCH OF SANTIAGO TLATELOLCO

Our day starts with breakfast at the hotel, followed by a morning conference and Holy Hour. We visit the Church of Santo Nino de la Paz after lunch, where we celebrate Mass. We continue to the Church of San José del Altillo to see the crypt where Blessed Conchita Cabrera is buried. Blessed Conchita was beatified at the OLG Basilica and she is the first Mexican laywoman to receive beatification. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City. (B.D)

[†]August 5, Tuesday, Day 4: THE PYRAMIDS OF THE SUN AND THE MOON

Our day starts with breakfast at the hotel, followed by a morning conference and Holy Hour. After lunch, we are on our way to Teotihuacan, we stop to visit the Church of the Fifth Apparition where we celebrate Mass. We continue to the archaeological site of Teotihuacan, where, we explore the Pyramids of the Sun and the Moon with a guided visit. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City. (B.D)

♥August 6, Wednesday, Day 5: **BLESSED MIGUEL PRO AND THE CHURCH OF SAGRADA FAMILIA**

After breakfast at the hotel, a morning conference, and Holy Hour. Following lunch, we visit Sagrada Familia Church where we celebrate Mass. We see the tomb and the Museum of Fr. Miguel Agustin Pro, the Jesuit Martyr, who was martyred in the Mexican Revolution of the early 20th century. We also visit the Church of Santo Domingo, where we can pray the Rosary at the Chapel of Our Lady of the Rosary. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City. (B. D)
